- **Committees:** To complement the work of the Board of Directors, a number of standing committees have been set in place, including the marketing and membership, scholarship and strategic planning committees. Also, ad hoc committees are created throughout the year to solicit feedback on new initiatives, programs and services.
- **Events:** Whether it's hole-spotting at a summer golf outing or greeting attendees at the fall Family Festival, the OUAA coordinates a number of events during the year that utilize volunteers in varying capacities.
- **Speaker/Presenter:** From panel discussions on career development to speaking at commencement, the OUAA relies on its alumni to share their knowledge and experience with students, faculty, community members and fellow alumni.
- **Mentoring:** Alumni are invited to help current students by mentoring in the CAST program online through Career Services, as well as in various networking and professional development events geared toward students and/or fellow alumni.
- **College/School Involvement:** The academic units appreciate the opportunity to work with alumni from their own departments on specialized projects, advisory boards, development initiatives, etc.
